The case

3. Bea shopping in Paris followed by an article on her father with speculations on his desire to make her heiress to the throne.
4. Bea taking a stroll in a busy street with her two dogs followed by an article discussing the princess' choice in fashion and men.
5. Bea next to her father King Gerald I. at the annual royal speech in Parliament.
6. Bea and Andreas in a busy street in Cape Town as illustration to an article of apartments rented out by celebrities.
7. Bea alone in a Café on Sunset Strip (Sunset Boulevard, L.A.) the day after her divorce.

Princess Bea filed for an injunction against the magazine to prohibit any further publications of photos with her without her consent at the courts of Germany to no avail.

She now applies to the Court claiming Germany disrespected her human rights.
